Lynn University today announced an expansion of its Summer Undergraduate Day offerings. Academic Affairs added 26 courses to its already-robust roster. Among the additions are six language, culture and career courses, traditionally reserved for the university's January Term (J-Term). The new courses courses allows students to get ahead in their degree programs or complete required coursework now and enjoy several weeks of Winter Break, later.

The move comes as government and public health officials continue to issue guidance that requires campus to remain closed for the foreseeable future.

"Our professors remain steadfast in their commitment to helping students succeed," said Vice President for Academic Affairs Katrina Carter-Tellison. "We know it takes time to establish a routine, and that once it's formed, it's easier to continue that routine than to pause and restart.
