As members of the university community prepare to return to campus following spring break, we ask our campus community to take extra precautions to prevent the spread of COVID-19 coronavirus.

- If you have traveled from or through China, South Korea, Iran, Italy or Japan in the past two weeks, you should follow the CDC's recommendations and implement a 14-day self-isolation before you return to Lynn University's campus. This applies to all residential and non-residential students, as well as employees and visitors.
- If you are a student and the self-isolation requirement applies to you, please contact the dean of students discuss your options at +1 561-237-7230. If you are an employee and this applies to you, contact Employee Services at +1 561-237-7290.
- If you have not recently traveled through these areas, we recommend following the same precautions for preventing flu or any other respiratory virus: wash your hands, cover your coughs and sneezes, and stay at home from work or school when you're sick.
