League members believe that canceling the season and all related game travel is the best option to safeguard our student-athletes and communities at this time.

The SSC will decide no later than Oct. 1 about basketball and swimming competitions scheduled for November and December.

The conference and the university will also explore creative approaches and alternatives to providing future competitive experiences for our fall sport student-athletes, including the possibility of conducting fall sports competition and conference championships in the spring semester.
