The campus pool and recreation courts are now open on a limited basis.

Monitors will ensure students and visitors follow appropriate distancing requirements, capacity limits and other protocols.

- Competitive play is not be permitted on recreation courts.
- Those waiting to use facilities must practice social distancing and wear facial coverings.
- Players must bring their own equipment.

Hours are Monday-Thursday, 3-8 p.m. and Friday-Sunday, 10 a.m.-8 p.m.

Campus pool

Capacity is 25 people on the pool deck and 15 inside the pool. Visitors can bring towels or their own portable seats. Lounge furniture is not available.

Recreation courts

- Basketball: 3-person limit per half court
- Tennis: open for non-competitive doubles play
- Fustal: 3-person limit per half goal
- Sand volleyball: 6 people per court

The Mary Ann and Harold Perper Intramural Field's open green space is available for play, with 20-person capacity including spectators. Hand slaps, huddles, shared water bottles and/or food are not permitted.

The Fitness Center remains closed.
