The Sunshine State Conference announced that it has canceled conference competition and championships for soccer, volleyball and swimming during the 2020–21 academic year.

It will also postpone the start of basketball season and decide in January whether to compete later in the spring should health conditions improve. This means that SSC teams will not participate in the 2021 NCAA Division II Men's and Women's Basketball Championships.

It will be determined at a later date whether a cross country conference championship can take place during the Spring 2021 semester.

This follows the SSC's careful consideration of many potential concerns and risks associated with the COVID-19 pandemic.

Lynn student-athletes will still have opportunities for conditioning and strength training, and coaches and athletics staff remain committed to helping students maximize their athletic performance and leadership skills.

The SSC and Lynn continue to evaluate health and safety regarding spring sports and will provide an update as soon as possible.
