Baseball, lacrosse and softball will compete in SSC spring season

Lynn University's baseball, lacrosse and softball teams will participate in Sunshine State Conference competition (SSC) during the 2021 spring semester. Team schedules are now available at lynnfightingknights.com.

Lynn's baseball and softball teams will compete starting March 3, men's lacrosse starts March 20 and women's lacrosse starts March 24.

The NCAA COVID-19 Medical Advisory Group has assessed these sports to be medium risk for transmission of COVID-19. Lynn will also be taking precautions including no spectators, adherence to social distancing guidelines and wearing masks when social distancing is not possible. Travel will be limited to Florida with reduced vehicle capacity and no hotel stays or air transportation. In addition, there will be no locker room use during home or away competitions.

The SSC established a COVID-19 disruption policy for the health and safety of the students, coaches and staff. Member institutions will monitor the impact of COVID-19 on athletics teams and the policy allows them to cancel a competition at any time without penalty, meaning the game is a no contest, and neither team earns a win or a loss.
