His conducting career spans the globe, from symphony orchestras in Norway, China, Egypt, South Africa and Austria to the Redlands Symphony Orchestra in California, where he has been principal conductor since 1982. Robertson continues to guest conduct and perform in concert as a member of the Archduke Trio.
