Updated COVID-19 protocols: masks required indoors

Please note that we are making an important change to our COVID-19 protocols based on guidance from health authorities. The CDC indicates that the transmission level of the Omicron variant is currently [high](#) in Palm Beach County and recommends [wearing masks](#) indoors in public regardless of individual vaccination status.

To help reduce the spread of the virus and keep us all healthy, we require that you **wear a mask any time you are indoors on campus** except when eating and drinking. No food or drink is allowed in classrooms.

As a reminder, perform a daily [self-check](#) for COVID-19 symptoms before entering campus. Stay home if you are feeling sick or have recently been exposed to or tested positive for COVID-19 and follow the latest [isolation and quarantine](#) guidelines from the CDC.

We are grateful for your partnership to help the Lynn community remain safe and healthy in order to provide a rewarding academic experience for our students this spring. We will continue to monitor local conditions and update community protocols as needed.
