Covid-19 Sent Poverty Rate Soaring

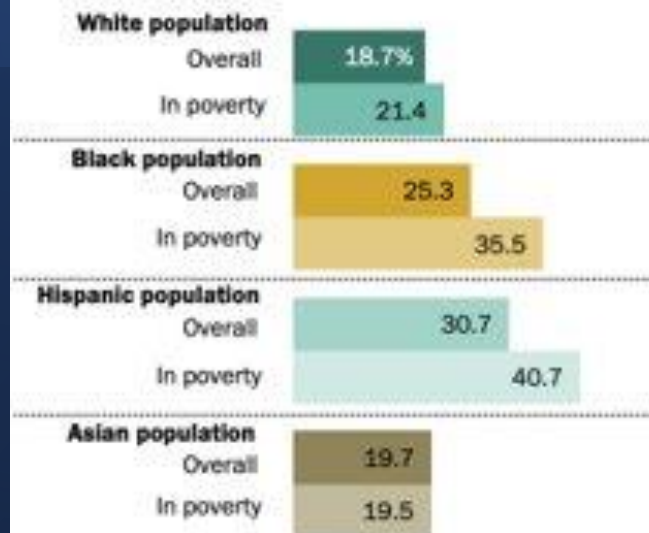
- ❖ Monthly child poverty rate prior the pandemic was 18.7% (Boghani, 2020)

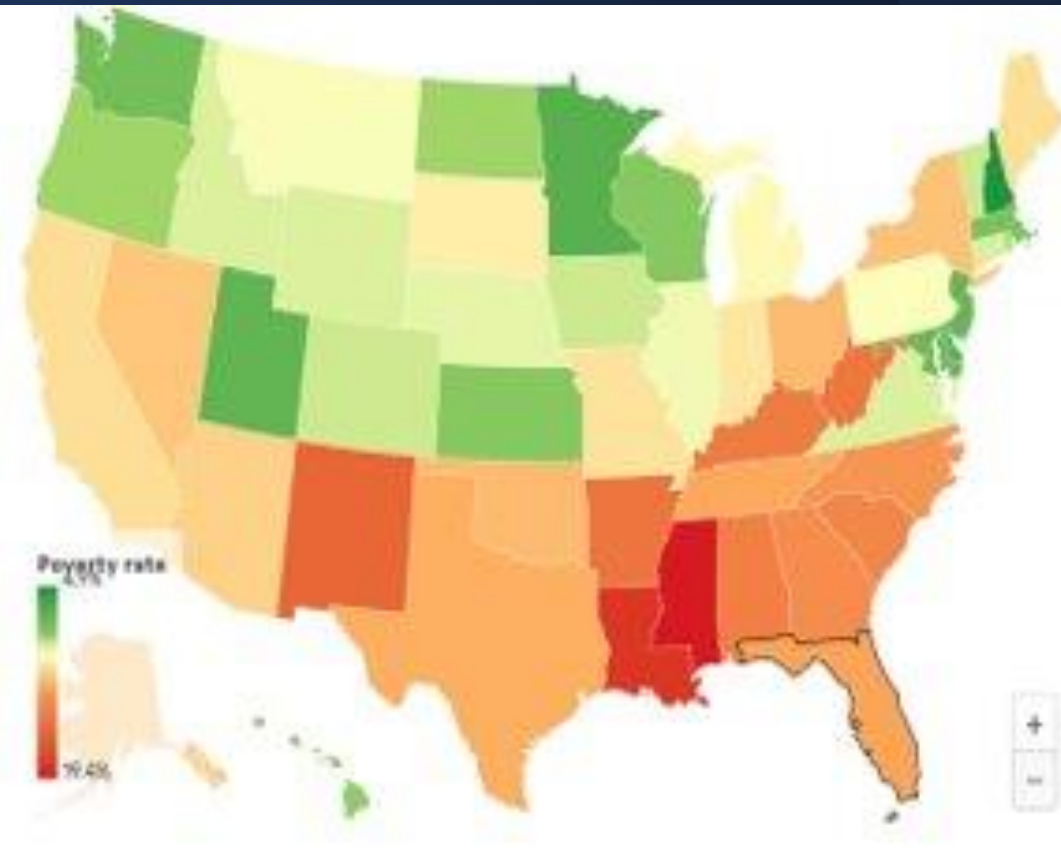
Children overrepresented among Black and Hispanic populations in poverty

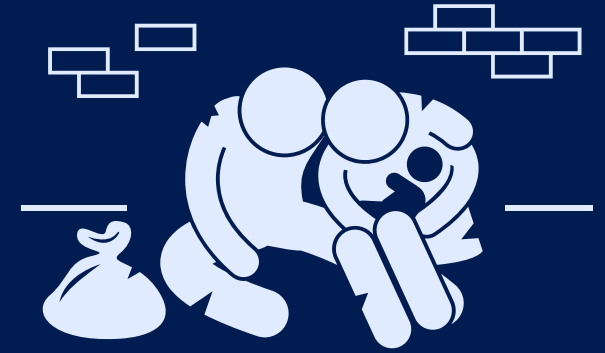


- ❖ Texas, 1.4 million children living in poverty (Stebbins, 2020).

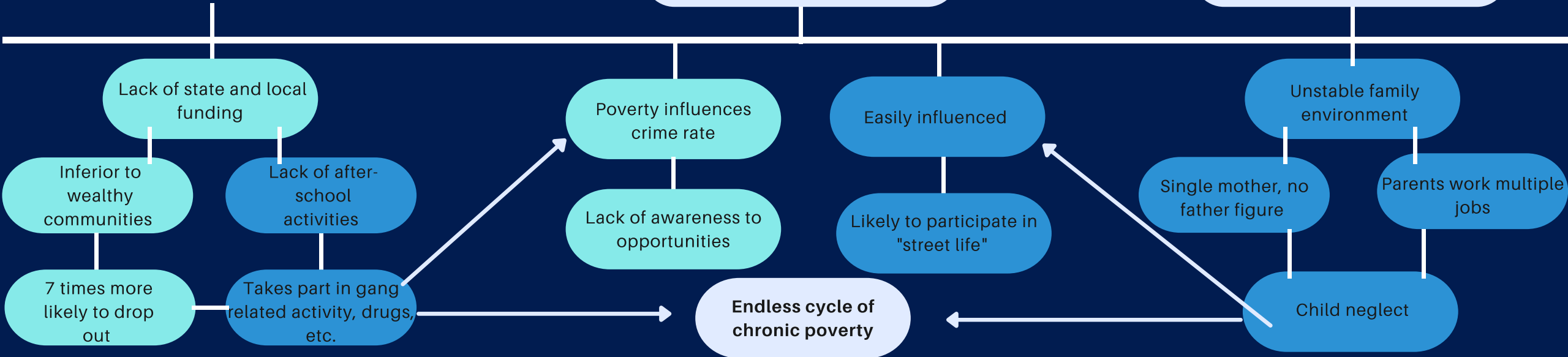
