

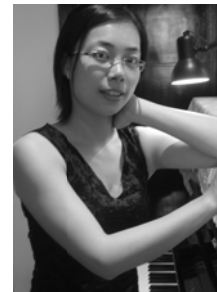

Ilie Curteanu was born in 1983 in Romania to a musical family and began playing the cello at age 8. Throughout high school and college he has attended master classes with world renowned cellists such as Alexandru Morosanu (Romania), Wolfgang Hertzner (Austria), Dimitrie Motatu (Spain), Laszlo Varga (Hungary-America) and Yehuda Hanani(U.S). During 2003-2007, Ilie has

performed as a soloist and chamber musician in South Florida and as an orchestral musician he has played with major orchestras such as the South West Florida Symphony, the New Philharmonic, the Symphony of the Americas and Palm Beach Symphony. He had many recitals, concerts and live radio broadcasts, such as the Romanian Radio Broadcasting Hall "Mihail Jora" and National Television. He has performed as a soloist in the year 2001 with the "Bacau Symphony Orchestra" and "Galati Symphony Orchestra." Ilie won several international and national competitions such as: "Citta di Pietra Ligure" in 1999(1 prize Absolute and Special prize) and 2000, National Olympiads (1997, 1998, 2001), Bacau National Competition (2001),Garabet Avachian National Competition(2001). As a very promising young cellist, Ilie was awarded a scholarship at the Lynn University Conservatory of Music in 2002 for his Undergraduate degree and where he is currently completing his Masters Degree, studying with renowned professor David Cole.



Yunyue Liu, pianist, was born in Shanghai, China in 1984. Yunyue started studying piano at the age of five. She studied as an undergraduate student at Shanghai Normal University in 2003 with Professor Shijie Ge and earned her Bachelor of Music Education in 2007. As a delegate of Shanghai Normal University, she was invited to perform in the Shanghai Spring International Music Festival in 2004, and an exchange performance in 2005 in Hong Kong. She obtained a

scholarship during the four years of her bachelor degree and was granted the Advanced Certificate in YAMAHA Fundamentals Grade 5 in 2007. She was the only person who passed the grade on that year of Shanghai Normal University. Presently, Yunyue is a Professional Performance Certificate student at Lynn University Conservatory, studying collaborative piano with Professor Tao Lin.
