Trombonist **Robert Harrover** is an in demand and emerging talent. A native Floridian, Mr. Harrover has performed in diverse musical situations from Walt Disney World to the Jacksonville Symphony Orchestra. Prior to entering Lynn University, He performed four seasons as principal trombone with Seaside Music Theatre in Daytona Beach, Florida and played lead trombone with the Mystic Sheiks of Morocco Brass Band at Busch Gardens Tampa Bay.

Mr. Harrover has also performed with such greats as Franki Valli and the Four Seasons and Natalie Cole, and was a finalist in the national auditions for the United States Army's Jazz Knights at West Point. In addition to performing, Mr. Harrover serves as Adjunct Professor of Trombone at Southeastern University in Lakeland, Florida. He is thrilled to be a part of the Conservatory at Lynn University and aspires to continue and expand his orchestral career.



Pianist **Agnieszka Sornek** holds a Master's Degree in Music Education from the Fryderyk Chopin Academy of Music in her native country of Poland. She taught piano, Dalcroze Eurhythmics and served as accompanist at the Karol Szymanowski School of Music in Warsaw before moving to the United States. Ms. Sornek graduated from Duquesne University with an

Artist Diploma in Piano Performance, studying with Kenneth Burky. More recently, she worked as a staff accompanist at Duquesne and was Music Director at Sacred Heart Parish in Emsworth until May, 2011. Currently, she is pursuing her Professional Performance Certificate in Collaborative Piano at Lynn University, studying with Lisa Leonard. Ms. Sornek is actively involved in the musical community as a teacher, accompanist and chamber musician.
