

Also, he has invited to play with Cluj Napoca National Opera from 2004-2006, Cluj-Napoca Philharmonic, Satu-Mare Philharmonic, Bern (Switzerland) Hochschule Orchestra, Ilmenau (Germany) Capella Juventa. He has been enrolled in fulltime music studies with maestro Elmar Oliveira, at Lynn University.
