Luis Bautista, flutist, was born in Cúcuta, Colombia. He began his musical studies with pianist Margarita Acevedo at age 15. From 1993-1995, Bautista continued his musical studies at the Instituto de Cultura y Bellas Artes de Cúcuta, where he received his high school diploma. In 1996 he moved to Bogota in order to study music technology and pedagogy at the Young

Symphony Orchestra from Colombia Foundation. In 2000 Mr. Bautista started to study at the Universidad Nacional de Colombia where he received his bachelor of music degree. Bautista served with the Young Symphony Orchestra from Colombia for ten years, as soloist, first flute, teacher and conductor. He was first flute at the Philharmonic Orchestra from Cundinamarca for two years as well as conductor and flute teacher from the National Foundation "BATUTA". Mr. Bautista studied with Luis Fernando Perez, Maria Nury Polania, Jaime Moreno, and Gaspar Hoyos. He received master classes with Tadeo Cohelo, Huascar Barradas, Luis Julio Toro, Wissan Boustanev, Willian Bennet, Antonio Naranjo, Nicaulis Auley, and Gabriel Ahumada. Mr. Bautista is now studying at Lynn University Conservatory pursuing a PPC (Professional Performance Certificate) with Renée Siebert.


