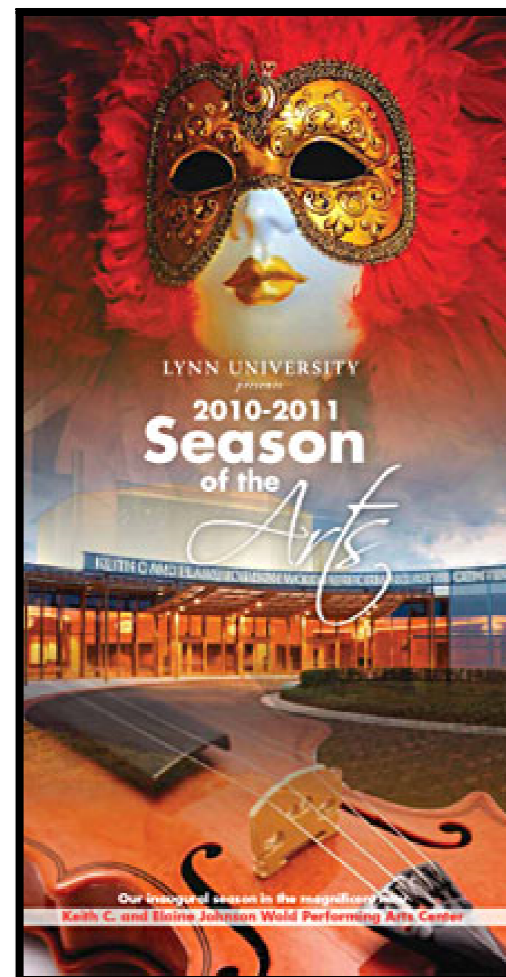

She placed first in the 2008 24th Montana State Concerto Competition and performed as a soloist on two occasions with the MSU Symphony. She served as substitute flutist with the Bozeman Symphony Orchestra and Billings Youth Orchestra. At Lynn, Kelley enjoys participating in woodwind quintet and the Lynn Philharmonia as well as studying with renowned flutist Renée Siebert.
