William Caballero joined the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra as Principal Horn in May of 1989, coming from the Principal Horn post with the Houston Symphony Orchestra. Previously he had been a member of l'Orchestre Symphonique de Montreal and the Hartford Symphony. He also has played and been a member of the Boston Symphony Orchestra, the Boston Pops, the Houston Grand Opera, l'Opera de Montreal, the Opera Company of Boston, and the New England Ragtime Ensemble. Summer Festivals include The Grand Teton Music Festival in Jackson Hole, Wyoming and the Bellingham Music Festival of Bellingham, Washington.

Born in New Mexico and reared in Wisconsin, Mr. Caballero graduated from the New England Conservatory, where he studied with Richard Mackey and Thomas Newell. Presently he is a faculty member at Duquesne University, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. He also was an artist teacher at Carnegie Mellon University and at the Rice University Shepherd School of Music, Houston, Texas.
