

Kasia Paciorkowska is originally from Bielsko-Biala, Poland. Her first instrument was piano and she began her musical career at the age of seven when she was accepted to study at the "Stanislaw Moniuszko Music School" where she received her primary through secondary education and graduated with honors. Although a gifted pianist, at age thirteen she began to study a secondary instrument, flute. Continuing to play

both piano and flute at the Academy of Music in Katowice and Silesian University, she graduated with a Bachelor in Flute Performance and Masters of Music Education and Choral Conducting. Kasia was affiliated with local orchestras and chamber groups in Silesia and South of Poland. She participated in many music festivals: Krakow Summer Music Festival, Swieradów's International Early Music Gatherings, "Warsaw Fall" International Festival of Contemporary Music, Alkagran, Gaude Fest and Las Vegas Music Festival. Kasia came to the U.S. in 2000 and began working with the Grammy Award winning "Brooklyn Youth Chorus" in New York City under the direction of Dianne Berkun as an associate conductor and accompanist. She also pursued her chamber music career performing with various ensembles at the Manhattan School of Music. Upon relocating to South Florida Kasia was invited to study flute with Christina Burr at the Conservatory at Lynn University where she is currently earning her Master's degree in flute performance. In addition Ms. Paciorkowska continues to actively perform and educate locally.


