Born in Seoul in 1988, to a musical family, **Seul-A** began violin training at age 4, and after two years of studying she was accepted into the Special Music School of Rimsky-Korsakov Conservatory of Music in St. Petersburg, Russia where she studied with Ludmilla Adjemova and Elena Zaitseva. While attending school, Seul-A embarked onto active

performing career, performing in major halls throughout the country, including Grand Hall of St. Petersburg Philharmonic and Maliy Hall of St. Petersburg Philharmonic. Her first appearance with the orchestra was at age 11, performing Wieniavsky Violin Concerto no.2 with the Symphony Orchestra of Tele-Radio of St. Petersburg, in the Glazunov Hall of St. Petersburg Conservatory of Music. She also featured soloist with the Chamber Orchestra of Estonia, the St. Petersburg Conservatory Symphony, the St. Petersburg State Symphony Orchestra, the Olympia Youth Philharmonic Orchestra, and Lynn Philharmonia Orchestra. She has won prizes from contests, including the First Prize at the "International Competition of Young Musicians Tallinn" in Estonia, the Second Prize at Austria's "Schloss Zell an der Pram" International Violin Competition, and the Second Prize at the Artist Series of Sarasota String Competition in Florida. She has performed in the master-classes of Ruggiero Ricci, Sylvia Rosenberg, Jan Repko, Andre Cardenes, Ida Heandel, Jaques Israelievitch, Yuvan Yaron, Charles Castleman, Orlando Cole(chamber music), and Maksim Fedotov. In 2006, Seul-A immigrated to the United States. In 2007, she was accepted to a studio of eminent violinist, Elmar Oliveira at Lynn University Conservatory of Music in Florida, with full scholarship.

Valeriya Polunina was born in Tashkent, Uzbekistan in 1982. She completed her specialized secondary education in Ekaterinburg Music Academy where she majored in both piano performance and music composition. In 2007, Valeriya completed her bachelor's degree at the Russian Music Academy named after the Gnesins where she studied with Professor M. Drozdova who is one of very few students of Professor M. Yudina. Valeriya has also completed a two-year degree in composition at Moscow State Conservatory named after P. Tchaikovsky. Valeriya is a winner of the first prize of the International competition "Russian Performing Art" dedicated to S. 'Rachmaninov. She is also a prize-winner of the International Piano Competition in London, England. Valeriya is an honorable winner of the "Russian Performing Art" Scholarship Award. She has participated in numerous master-classes in England, Russia and this past summer in the Tel-Hai International Piano Master Classes in Israel. Valeriya has performed numerous concerts in Russian, Ukrainian and European cities as a soloist as well as a member of various chamber ensembles. She has also played with symphony orchestras which include Ekaterinburg Symphony, Simferopol Symphony, and Russian Academy of Music Symphony. Valeriya is currently completing the Master of Music program at a Lynn University Conservatory of Music, Boca Raton, Florida, with Professor Roberta Rust.


