Jeffrey Irvine, Fynette H. Kulas Professor of Viola at the Cleveland Institute of Music, was professor of viola at the Oberlin Conservatory of Music from 1983 to 1999 and was chair of the string division there from 1992 to 1999. His students have gone on to major orchestral, teaching and chamber music posts across the country and around the world and have often been first prize winners in major viola competitions, including the Primrose Competition, the ASTA National Solo Competition, and the Washington International Competition. During the summer, Mr. Irvine is on the faculty of the ENCORE School for Strings and the Aspen Music Festival.
