Yuan (Callum) Yao started learning trumpet at the age of 11 with Shanghai conservatory Prof. Chan Dawei. In 1993, he was accepted into the Music School of the Shanghai Conservatory. He got his first diploma and graduated in 1999.

In 2000, he earned the Singapore Ministry of Education Scholarship to study with Mr. Richard Adams at the Nan Yang Academy of Fine arts. He was awarded an Undergraduate Diploma in Music in 2003. Meanwhile, he was the recipient of the Singapore National Arts and culture scholarship from Singapore National University, where he studied with Mr. Laurence Gargan.

He performs regularly with the Lynn University conservatory orchestra, Brass band and Quintet. He was a member of the Shanghai conservatory orchestra, Singapore Symphony Orchestra (freelance), and the Singapore Youth Orchestra.
