For that recognition she has being invited as a special guest to play in bands and groups as Tiao Carvalho (folklore music), Pracatum-Carlinhos Brown (Bahian Music), Cleber Lucas, Binho Almeida and Touch of Power (gospel music), and also as a performer and producer at the bands JMF (country music), Hi-Fi (Soul and pop music), Gospel and Jazz bands, and to play in classical concerts.

In March 2004, she received a letter of recognition at the event "celebrities of Florida" as an important person contributing for the growth to the intercultural world of the arts in South Florida.

Extending her artistic appreciation side she worked and participated on the creation of musical theaters as the show "Mala de Mascate", presented in 2003, where she acted, played and sang.

Between the many musical works that she has explored we can highlight her recordings and productions at diverse studios, lessons of piano, electric bass and voice, and also vocal compositions.

Her participation and contribution in Music Festivals were constants from 1999 to 2003 in Londrina-PR, Brazil and other states.
