

Trigger Ban: All abortions are banned except to save the pregnant persons life, rape, or incest.	Constitutional protections for abortion
Transgressing Mississippi's abortion restrictions will lead to civil and criminal penalties	Affirms the right to health care providers to perform abortions prior to twenty-four weeks of pregnancy




