Danut Muresan, violin

Danut Muresan, born in 1981 in Timisoara, Romania, started playing the violin at the age of 4. He completed his music high school studies (under the direct observation of Mrs. Lucretia Fernback, Mr. Radu Bozgan and Mrs. Maria Clesiu) in his native city with the concert master and the director of the “Banatul” Philharmonic Orchestra, Mr. Hans Fernbach. He has taken part in 5 international and 6 national violin competitions where he has won top prizes. His most important competitions are “Kocian” International Violin Competition, Czech Republic, 1991 (3rd prize); Stresa, Italy, 1994 (1st prize); San Bartholomeo, Italy, 1995 (1st prize); Brasov, Romania, 1992 (2nd prize) and 1995 (3rd prize).

His activities as a soloist includes concerts with Banatul Philharmonic Orchestra in 1991 and 1999; recitals in and around Heidelberg, Germany starting in 1994 until 2000; Paris, France, 1995, and Romania (Sibiu 1993, Timisoara and Arad, various years). He played in the International Youth Orchestra “Elbe Weser” in Germany from 1997 to 2000, and is an active member of the South West Florida Symphony Orchestra and the Symphony of the Americas since 2000. He is a former member of the Miami Symphony (2000-2001). Danut recorded for the Romanian National Radio and TV stations in 1996, 1997, and 1998. He has participated in Master Classes held by well-known artists including Petru Munteanu, 1995; Laszlo Kis, 1996; Paul Florin, 1997; Stefan Gheorghiu, 1995-1998; and Sergiu Schwartz, 1999. In 2000, Danut was awarded with a full tuition scholarship by the Conservatory of Music at Lynn University in Boca Raton, Florida, where he is currently completing his Bachelor of Music degree in violin performance. Danut is a student of Mr. Sergiu Schwartz.
