David Suarez, flute

David Suarez, a native of Puerto Rico, David began studying the flute at New World School of the Arts in Miami, under the tutelage of Susan De Gooyer and Barbara Sesiel. David has studied with Charles Delany at Florida State University and is currently a student of Lea Kibler at the Conservatory of Music at Lynn University. He was the first prize-winner of the Florida Flute Association Young Artist Competition and finalist in the New York String Seminar.

David is former Principal Flutist with the South Florida Youth Symphony and The Youth Orchestra of the Americas as part of the Pablo Casals Festival in San Juan, Puerto Rico where he served for 2 consecutive summers. He has appeared in public radio broadcasts and has performed in Master Classes with James Walker, Peter Lloyd, Richard Sherman and Peter Kirn. David has been featured in recordings for children stories as part of the WFSU story time for kids. In addition, David also coordinates adult music classes for the Institute for Learning in Retirement in Boca Raton.
