# Sanghee Lisa Jung, violin

South Korean violinist Sanghee (Lisa) Jung started playing the violin the age of 11 at her elementary school in Seoul. In 1994, at the age of 14, she came to the United States to attend Idyllwild Arts Academy in California. Lisa has performed with the Idyllwild Chamber Orchestra in the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration Concert at The Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts in Washington D.C. under the direction of Leonardo Slatkin, and Jung-Ho Pak. She has attended National Orchestral Institute, Aspen Music Festival and Brevard Music Center. In 1997, she participated in the Escandido Competition in San Diego, CA and received the price of performing at the Gala Concert Hall in Mexico.

Lisa has performed in orchestras under the direction of Michael Stern, Gerard Schwartz, Stanislaw Skrowaczkeski, David Effran, Yehundi Gilad, Arthur Weisberg and others. Recently, Lisa performed in a Master Class for Arnold Steinhardt of the Guarneri String Quartet. She currently studies with Sergiu Schwartz at the Conservatory of Music at Lynn University in Boca Raton, FL.
