Born in 1979 in Nice, France, Anne Chicheportiche entered the Conservatory of Antibes at the age of seven and won the Gold Medal at graduation. She continued her studies at the Conservatoire National Régional in Paris winning First Prize. She received her Bachelor's degree from the University of Nice in France and in 1999, she moved to Switzerland to begin studies at the Geneva Conservatory, where she received her Soloist Diploma.

Anne has studied with Stefan Gheorghiu, Margarita Piguet-Karafilova, and Suzanne Gessner. She is currently pursuing a Professional Studies Diploma at the Conservatory of Music at Lynn University, where she studies with artist faculty Sergiu Schwartz.
