Viktor Dulguerov, violin

Born in a family of musicians in Sofia, Bulgaria, Viktor Dulguerov started playing the violin at the age of five. He studied at the Sofia School of Music, where he received his high school diploma in 1999. During the same year, he was awarded a scholarship from the Lynn University Conservatory of Music where he is presently completing his Bachelor of Music Degree in Violin Performance as a student of artist faculty Sergiu Schwartz.

Viktor performed as soloist with the Shumen Philharmonic Orchestra and Gabrovo Chamber Orchestra. He also appeared in radio and TV broadcasts, including *Young Talents*, a show on the Bulgarian National TV. His future engagements include recitals and solo appearances in Bulgaria and Switzerland. Recently, he was awarded a scholarship from the Saint Kiril and Metody Foundation. He is currently a member of the Miami Symphony and Southwest Florida Symphony.
