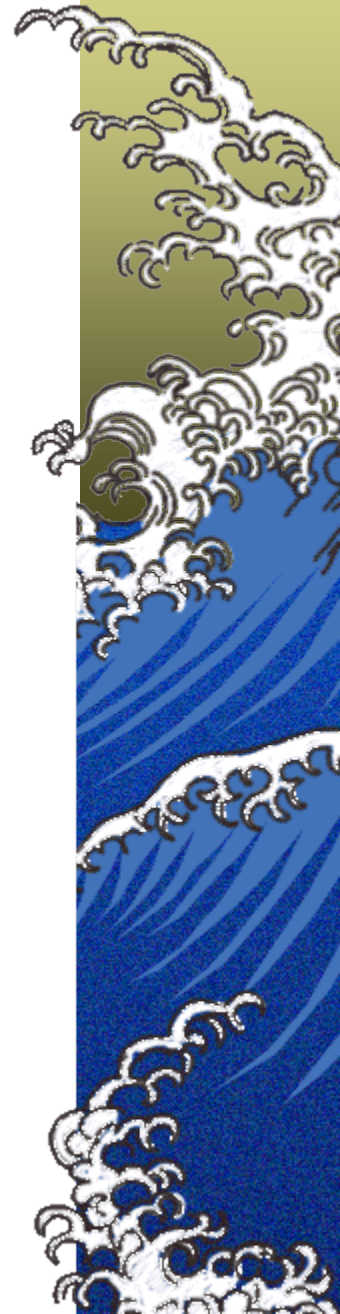

# Universal Design Learning

UDL is an educational framework based on research in the learning sciences, including cognitive neuroscience, that guides the development of flexible learning environments that can accommodate individual learning differences.

- ▶ Provide multiple means of
  - ▶ Representation
  - ▶ Action & Expression
  - ▶ Engagement
- ▶ Develop Curriculum that identifies
  - ▶ Goals
  - ▶ Methods
  - ▶ Materials
  - ▶ Assessments



## UDL Concepts (2)

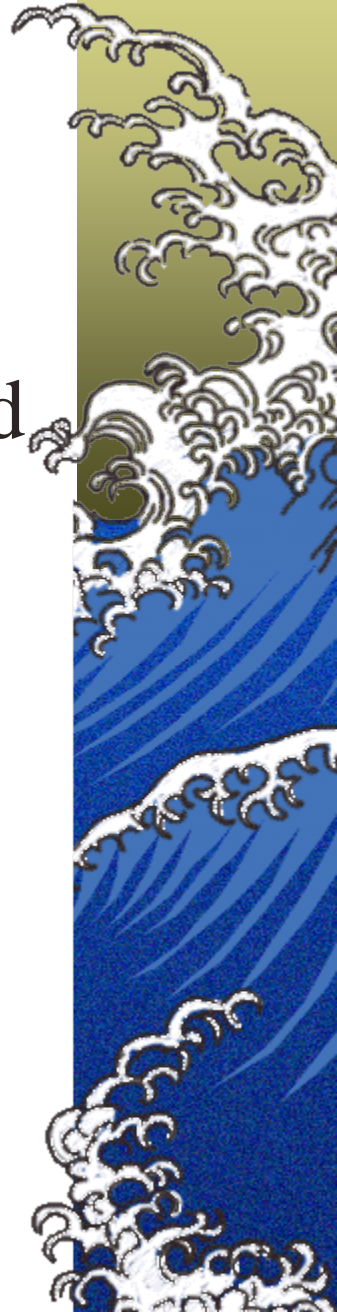
<b>Representation</b>	<b>Action and Expression</b>	<b>Engagement</b>
<b>Perception</b>	<b>Physical action</b>	<b>Recruiting interest</b>
<b>Language, expressions, and symbols</b>	<b>Expression and communication</b>	<b>Sustaining effort and persistence</b>
<b>Comprehension</b>	<b>Executive function</b>	<b>Self-regulation</b>

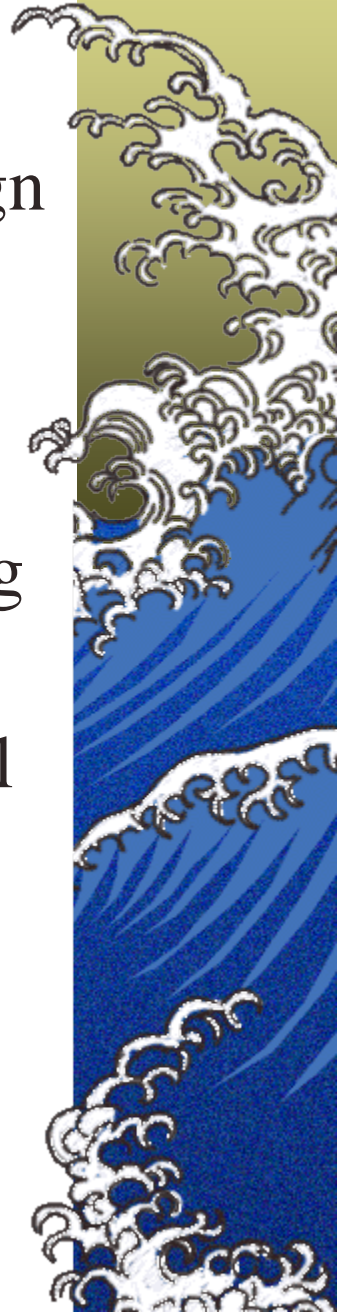
## Why You Won't Have Difficulty ...
